

Read this information carefully before using the Vida E+ Throttle. Safety instructions are very important and should not be overlooked. By reading the manual, you will better understand the general operation of the product.

Before installing and using the throttle, it is important to understand and comply with your area's local laws and regulations, as these may vary by country or state.

Ensuring that you follow the rules is your responsibility, and wearing appropriate safety equipment, such as a helmet, is essential for a safe and responsible riding experience.

Only use the Vida E+ Throttle with supplied installation hardware.



WARNING

Improper installation or damage to the Vida E+ Throttle and hand grip could cause the rider to lose control and serious injury or death. Do not modify the Vida E+ Throttle in any way.

Check if the wiring and throttle are secure and functioning before every ride. Do not use the Vida E+ Throttle to move or lift the bike.

Periodically check all bolts are tight, as vibrations may loosen them over time.

Regularly check the state of the Vida E+ Throttle and mounting parts for any signs of looseness, deterioration, corrosion or other damage.

Ensure that no parts, accessories or body parts come in contact with moving parts of the bicycle, such as tire, spokes or chain.

Using a throttle is a different experience than pedaling; please be familiar with how to use and control it before riding in traffic.

If you are not confident with compatibility and installation of this product, please consult your local authorized dealer.

Installation

Vida E+ Throttle and hand grip are installed on the right-hand side of the handlebar.

1. Ensure the bike is off before installation.
2. Remove any accessories and parts that may interfere with the installation and disassemble the hand grip on the right-hand side of the handlebar.
3. Find the throttle cable connector located under the plastic coiled cable protector outside the bike frame in proximity of the handlebar and stem. Remove the waterproof plug.
4. Connect the throttle cable with the connector, organize the wiring and reinstall the coiled cable protector wrapping (if needed).
5. Re-position the throttle with the fixed screw facing downwards, and use a 3mm hex torque wrench to tighten the bolt with 2-3Nm.
6. Assemble the washer (convex side facing throttle).
7. Install the hand grip and use a 3mm hex torque wrench to tighten the underside bolt of the hand grip with 2-3Nm.
8. Insert the rubber plug into the end of the handlebar.
9. Double-check that the Vida E+ Throttle is properly installed. The Vida E+ Throttle should not move or rotate in any direction.
10. Attach the legal sticker on the seat tube while covering the original one on the bike.



WARNING

Notice to check to ensure grip properly tight before each ride and that failure to properly install could cause serious injury or death. If unsure of proper tightness, do not ride and consult with an authorized retailer for service assistance.

Usage information

How to use Vida E+ Throttle

- To use the throttle assist, begin briefly pedaling the Vida E+ and upon reaching a speed of 0.6MPH/ 1KPH engage the throttle by carefully twisting it back towards the pilot. After the throttle is applied, the rider can stop pedaling entirely and use your wrist to control the speed of the Vida E+.
- Twist a little or twist further to make the Vida E+ go quicker (up to 20MPH/ 32KPH). Release the throttle or apply the brakes and the power is cut from the motor (no motor assistance).



WARNING

Always maintain control of your speed by keeping your hands on the grips and rear brakes while in motion.



WARNING

Depending on your e-bike model; you may be able to customize your max pedal assist speed limit ≤ 28mph (45km/h).

Please be advised that adjusting your bike's max pedal assist speed may change your bike's legal classification. This classification may be subject to specific local laws and regulations that vary by jurisdiction. Including but not limited to; Multi-class restrictions, labeling & equipment requirements.

It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with and comply with any applicable laws or regulations regarding electric bicycles in your area. Failure to adhere to these regulations could result in fines, penalties, or restrictions on the use of your bike. Always exercise caution and ensure that you are operating your bike within the legal limits of your location.



INFO

When you engage the throttle on the Vida E+, the display automatically switches to show the remaining riding range based on Power mode.

Once you release the throttle, the display reverts to showing the range according to your current pedal-assist mode (ECO, Active, or Power).
